Purple Beauty Sweet Pepper





Capsicum annum 'Purple Beauty' (65 to 70 days from sow)

- <u>Use</u>: Purple peppers are always a favorite, as they are so colorful. This variety produces loads of beautiful bells on compact, bushy plants. Crisp texture and mild, sweet flavor makes this one popular with everyone.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- <u>Growth</u>: Plants are 24-36" tall and multibranching.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 9-11; Annual,
- *Foliage:* Small green leaves
- <u>Flower:</u> This stunning bell pepper is ready to eat when the fruits turn deep purple with a green undertone. The crisp, succulent, 4-lobed, thick- walled fruit adds color and nutrition to salads and fresh vegetable platters, and turns green when cooked. The plants are very productive.

You can grow them in a pot on your patio!
