

# Purple Beauty Sweet Pepper



You can grow them in a pot on your patio!

***Capsicum annuum 'Purple Beauty'*** (65 to 70 days from sow)

- **Use:** Purple peppers are always a favorite, as they are so colorful. This variety produces loads of beautiful bells on compact, bushy plants. Crisp texture and mild, sweet flavor makes this one popular with everyone.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Plants are 24-36" tall and multibranching.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11; Annual,
- **Foliage:** Small green leaves
- **Flower:** This stunning bell pepper is ready to eat when the fruits turn deep purple with a green undertone. The crisp, succulent, 4-lobed, thick-walled fruit adds color and nutrition to salads and fresh vegetable platters, and turns green when cooked. The plants are very productive.
