

Spineless Perfection Squash



*High yielding, medium-green type. A spineless zucchini with darker, glossier fruit.

*An easy pick plant with open habit, enhanced disease resistance package and straight, cylindrical fruit with minimal scarring. This is an excellent mid to late season variety.

Cucumis pepo 'Spineless Perfection'

- **Use**: Attractive, straight fruits are borne on a spineless, open plant which makes harvesting easy. Multiple disease resistances keep the plants bearing over an extended period. Intermediate resistance to powdery mildew, watermelon mosaic virus, and zucchini yellow mosaic virus.
- **Exposure/Soil**: Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth**: Plant every 18" in rows 6' apart.
- **Hardiness**: **Zone** 9-11, Annual,
- **Fruit/Flower**: The medium-green fruit have more flecking than Spineless Beauty and have a unique stem characteristic that allows for easy twist harvest without breaking the fruit at the stem. Its intermediate resistance to ZYMV, WMV and powdery mildew helps to insure good yields.
