## Candyland Tomato



Each dark red fruit is round, smooth, and just about ½-inch in diameter, weighing in at ¼-ounce, yet every bit is packed with super sweet, rich flavor. You will quickly get used to grabbing a handful of Candyland Reds every time you enter the vegetable garden—they're a wonderful snack straight off the vine.



## Lycopersicum 'Candyland' (Indeterminate)

- <u>Use</u>: Tomato Candyland Red is the only AAS award-winning currant-type tomato. Currant tomatoes are smaller in size than cherry-type and are ready to "pop" in your mouth straight from the garden. Gardeners will appreciate the dark red, sweet-flavored fruit that can be enjoyed throughout the season.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Grows 24" tall and 24" wide.
- *Hardiness: Zone* 9-11, Annual, Houseplant.
- Foliage: Lacy leaves
- <u>Fruit:</u> Expect more than 100 fruit from every plant—Candyland Red sets its currant tomatoes in long clusters, like enormous bunches of grapes. The production is heavy and continues all season long on this vigorous, trouble free plant.
