This hardy evergreen delights as an accent, in containers or mass plantings, with a compact habit, striking red stems, and elongated dark red/ purple leaves. Its small, compact form makes this introduction virtually maintenance free, while exhibiting show stopping changes in color. Hard to find!
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers part sun; moist, well drained soil; dislikes wet sites. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- <u>Growth</u>: Low mounding shrub 2-3 feet tall and 2-3' wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 6a -9b Shrub
- <u>Foliage</u>: Evergreen. Dark red new foliage ages to green in summer and purple in winter.
- Flower: Not known for flowers.
