

Burning Love Leucothoe



Compact, evergreen shrub with deep red spring growth, turning to green in summer, followed



by dark purple in the fall. Best foliage color with afternoon shade, but can tolerate full sun.

- **Use:** Your garden will be ablaze with color from fall to spring with Burning Love Leucothoe. This hardy evergreen delights as an accent, in containers or mass plantings, with a compact habit, striking red stems, and elongated dark red/purple leaves. Its small, compact form makes this introduction virtually maintenance free, while exhibiting show stopping changes in color. Hard to find!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers part sun; moist, well drained soil; dislikes wet sites. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Low mounding shrub 2-3 feet tall and 2-3' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6a -9b Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Dark red new foliage ages to green in summer and purple in winter.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
