

White Mandevilla Trellis



Great to train on your mailbox.

***Mandevilla boliviensis* 'Alba'**

- **Use:** A lush, flowering tropical vine features a bounty of long-lasting 2- to 3-inch wide pure white blooms with yellow throats. Its glossy green foliage and twining habit make it an excellent choice for a trellis, container or plant in the pot directly in the garden as they like to be root-bound slightly. So easy to grow! They will tolerate the hottest sun and humidity! Attracts lots of hummingbirds. Great to climb up your mailbox.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full- part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Prefers to be root bound so if you plant in the ground be sure to plant them pot and all in the ground so you can easily bring it inside for the winter.
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to 36-48" in. tall or more. For more flowers pinch the tips of the stems occasionally early in the season.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11; Annual , Does not like temps below 50 degrees, but loves the heat.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long oval leaves.
- **Flower:** Large white trumpets. Blooms April- October nonstop!
