- **Use:** mounded, upright plants are ideal for shady landscapes and mixed containers. Bright and colorful foliage makes this care free plant a showstopper in any garden or container. This tough garden plant thrives in heat and will stay lush and healthy all summer. No need to prune or deadhead.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results.
- **Growth:** Growing just 15-18 inches tall and wide , it's a favorite plant for use in formal knot gardens or as edging to define plant beds.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 9-11 Annual, Houseplant
