Easy to grow long spikes of blooms from spring to fall.

Angelonia 'Serena Purple'

- **Use:** We plant these in our garden every year, because they perform in the heat and add elegant color to the garden!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun –part shade. Prefers moist, well-drained soil.
- **Growth:** Grows 12-14” tall and spreads. Great for window boxes, flower beds, and mixed containers.
- **Hardiness:** 8-9; annual, but with some protection there is a chance they may come back.
- **Foliage:** Small leaves.
- **Flower:** Blooms all season; heat and drought tolerant plants; grape-scented foliage; low maintenance. Prune off old flower stems.
