Begonia 'Gryphon'

- Use: These large, tropical-looking leaves, a variegated silver and green, prove just how dramatic foliage plants can be. We especially love it combined with Impatiens and Begonias in mixed annual collections.
- The genus Begonia offers a wide selection of outstanding foliage as well as flowers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers. Most plants need bright, indirect light, well-drained soil, at least 50% humidity, and warm temperatures (70-75°F) to be at their best. During the summer, they become one of the most stylish and exciting plants for shade.
- **Growth:** Grows 16-20" tall and 16-20" wide, maybe taller if deep shade or rich soil. Use in patio containers, hanging baskets and beds
- Hardiness: 9-11, annual, Can also be used as a houseplant
- Foliage: Its large, maple-like leaves are deep green splashed with silver and hints of purple.
- Flower: Not known for flowers.
