

Cora Cora Trailing Vinca or Periwinkle Basket



Cataranthus roseus 'Cora' Cora Cascade'

- **Use:** Plants are so well-branched they start to spread early on, creating a nice mounded, trailing habit, and produce large flowers with overlapping petals. Great when used in baskets, beds, borders, or containers. They love the heat and thrive in the warmest Georgia summers. This cultivar is resistant to rot and the best one on the market!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Grows 12-15" tall and 15-18" wide.
- **Hardiness:** 9-11, annual, houseplant. Protect from temperatures below 40 degrees.
- **Foliage:** Small leaves.
- **Flower:** Vibrant colors! Blooms from spring to fall with little maintenance.
