Use in rock gardens, mixed containers and desert plantings.

Echeveria 'Lady Grey'

- **Use:** There are so many succulents to choose from—how do you pick? Coral Reef Red gets top marks for its stunning bright-red ruffled edges. In colder climates, place pots into borders to enjoy all summer, then bring inside near a sunny window to over-winter.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to light shade in a well-drained soil and irrigate regularly to occasionally in spring and summer.
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow 10” tall and 12” wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11; Annual; Very heat tolerant! Bring indoor in winter into a sunny room. Hardy to 25 °F.
- **Foliage:** Varies by cultivar.
- **Flower:** Hot coral red flowers appear on slender, green stems which emerge from the sides of the rosette from late summer into fall. The contrast between flower and foliage is truly striking.
