

Lady Grey Echeveria



Echeveria 'Lady Grey'

- **Use:** This plant's rosettes are so perfect looking, you'll find yourself touching them to make sure they're real!
- Dramatic foliage adds wonderful contrast to succulent plantings and rock gardens. Well suited to containers, both indoors and out. Best in containers that can be winter protected where temperatures can drop lower.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to light shade in a well-drained soil and irrigate regularly to occasionally in spring and summer.
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow 4-10" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11; Annual; Very heat tolerant! Bring indoor in winter into a sunny room. Hardy to 25 °F.
- **Foliage:** Frosty –gray leaves form a perfect rosette that is a real conversation piece of symmetry.
- **Flower:** Hot coral red flowers appear on slender, green stems which emerge from the sides of the rosette from late summer into fall. The contrast between flower and foliage is truly striking.

Use in container rock gardens or as a houseplant in a sunny window.
