

Perle von Nurnberg Echeveria



Use in rock gardens, mixed containers and desert plantings.



Echeveria 'Perle von Nurnberg'

- **Use:** Beautiful rosettes of soft grey-brown leaves with deep pink highlights are dusted in powdery white. Bright coral flowers emerge in summer on foot-long reddish stems. Adds beauty to rock gardens and succulent collections. Tolerant of heat and drought. A frost-tender evergreen. In colder climates, place pots into borders to enjoy all summer, then bring inside near a sunny window to overwinter.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to light shade in a well-drained soil and irrigate regularly to occasionally in spring and summer.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing; rosettes reach 8 to 10 in. tall, 6 to 8 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11; Annual; Very heat tolerant! Bring indoor in winter into a sunny room. Hardy to 25 °F.
- **Foliage:** Varies by cultivar. Lovely pink color and elegant leaf shape.
- **Flower:** Hot coral red flowers appear on slender, green stems which emerge from the sides of the rosette from late summer into fall. The contrast between flower and foliage is truly striking.
