Euphorbia 'White Flash'

- **Use:** Has a tight and compact habit and will show its white flowers throughout the summer. Heat and drought tolerant, deer resistant, and self-cleaning (no deadheading necessary). Great for combination planting or hanging baskets. This Euphorbia is a winner in any container or garden, sun or shade!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun, but will tolerate shade. In our area they must have well-drained sandy soil to thrive in our wet winters. They are very drought tolerant. Requires a dry location with good drainage, especially in areas of high rainfall.
- **Growth:** Grows 20" tall and 36" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-11; Annual; May have luck with it returning with a good mulching
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Glaucous blue leaves.
- **Flower:** Bright white 'clouds' of flowers are a perfect compliment to any planting all the way until frost!
