

Fragrant Heliotrope



Heliotropium arborescens 'Marine'

- **Uses:** . In summer, it bears a profusion of fragrant deep violet-blue flowerheads up to 6 inches across. Use as bedding or border plant, in windowboxes and in containers. Heat tolerant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun to shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Prefers not to be overwatered.
- **Growth:** Broadly compact form 6-12" high and 1-2' wide.
- **Hardiness:** 9-11, Annual, May overwinter if mild winter. You can bring indoors as a houseplant.
- **Foliage:** Broadly oval to lance-shaped, wrinkled leaves tinged with purple.
- **Flower:** Large clusters of deep purple, vanilla-scented flowers all summer.
