Matthiola incana 'Hot Cakes'

- **Use:** Sturdy, well-branched plants produce an abundance of early bright, fragrant flowers. They are excellent for cutting for small bouquets. Prefers cool growing conditions. Adds flavor and fragrance to cool-area or cool-season bedding displays.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun-part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Grows 10-16" tall and wide
- **Hardiness:** **Zone 7-9;** Tender Perennial/ Annual; (Hates summer heat, but will re-seed or you can save seeds)
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen; Small silvery-green leaves.
- **Flower:** Produces double flowers on short, well-branching plants. Flower colors include rose, white, and lilac.
