Nicotiana 'Saratoga Series'

- **Use:** Nicotiana or flowering tobacco is a lovely heirloom flower gaining recognition among today's gardeners. Their beauty is appealing and their fragrance is alluring. This ornamental fills the summer garden with large, brightly colored trumpets of star-shaped flowers that attract butterflies and hummingbirds. Older nicotiana species are valued for their impressive stature and deliciously scented flowers that open in early evening. It thrives on the very same weather that makes others flop and give up the ghost! You will love it!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Grows 20" tall and 12" wide.
- **Hardiness:** 9-11, annual, houseplant. Protect from temperatures below 40 degrees.
- **Foliage:** Small leaves.
- **Flower:** These blooms are 2 inches long, shaped like magnificently long trumpets, and very, very abundant. And unlike some Flowering Tobaccos, these blooms face upward, so you can enjoy their full splendor in planters, along the front of the border, edging the walkway, or dotted around the patio garden!
