

Margarita Orange Flare Spoon Daisy



Osteospermum 'Margarita Orange Flare'

- **Use:** Beautiful orange-yellow daisy flowers appear all season on compact plants with a nice branching habit and outstanding flower shape; heat tolerant and low maintenance; a great addition to the garden or containers .
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Be sure to try to keep water off the leaves and water early in the morning only.
- **Growth:** Moderate-growing to 12" high, 8-12" wide.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 8/9-11, Annual, Houseplant, Protect from temperatures below 40 degrees.
- **Foliage:** Small leaves.
- **Flower:** Bathed in stunning orange daisy flowers with yellow overtones and steel blue eyes at the ends of the stems from late spring to mid fall. The flowers are excellent for cutting. Its spiny narrow leaves remain green in color throughout the season. The fruit is not ornamentally significant. Bloom spring to fall frost. Remove spent flowers. Deer resistant!

Reminiscent of a solar eclipse! Yellow, daisy-like flower petals radiate out from a dark center with bronze tips. Attracts butterflies!
