## *Pelargonium 'Americana Series'*

- **Use:** One of the most popular plants for containers, geraniums are known for their large, vibrant, lollipop blooms. The bloom clusters of the Americana series can get up to 4 or 5 inches across. They will hold together better in the wind, rain and heat without shattering like some varieties. Butterflies and hummingbirds will flock to the fragrant blooms but deer and rabbits tend to stay away.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Loves full sun or at least 4-5 hours of afternoon sun. They love the heat! Water 2-3 times a week. Try to keep water off of the leaves. Remove spent flowers and the whole stem. Requires well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. **Water regularly under the leaves.** If you are not good at watering get some **Soil Moist.** In extreme heat it may need daily watering.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower 12-20" high and wide.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 9-11 Annual, houseplant. Bring inside in winter.
- **Foliage:** Cutting grown for excellent vigor! Strong and floriferous unlike less vigorous seed varieties found at other dept stores.
- **Flowers:** Will bloom from spring to fall frost.
