Pelargonium 'Great Balls of Fire'

- **Use:** This is an Ivy Geranium series that boasts large blooms and was bred for heat tolerance! Against light and bright green, sharply lobed, ivy-like leaves, these flowers are a real eye-catcher and will bloom even during the hottest temperatures, as proven by their garden performance in their trial year. All ivy geraniums in the Great Balls of Fire series are suited well to coastal living! Use in hanging baskets, containers, or in the ground.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Loves full sun or at least 4-5 hours of afternoon sun. They love the heat! Water 2-3 times a week, but may need daily watering with 90 degree plus temps. If you are not good at watering get some Soil Moist. Try to keep water off of the leaves. Remove spent flowers and the whole stem. Requires well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly under the leaves.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower trails to 24" long.
 - **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11; Annual, Houseplant
 - **Foliage:** Dainty, ivy-shaped, green leaves.
 - **Flowers:** Some of the most exotic flowers you will ever see! Will bloom from spring to fall frost. Pick off seed pods for more blooms.
