

Stars & Stripes Penta



Penta lanceolata 'Stars & Stripes'

- **Use:** This tall garden plant can be grown in both northern and southern garden beds and patio containers. Also called "Egyptian starflowers". Pentas are quickly becoming one of the most popular summer container and landscape plants. Large star shaped flowers up to 3 inches across that attract butterflies and hummingbirds.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Grows 12-24" high with a clumping habit.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8/9-11 Annual /tender perennial if we have a mild winter. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Lush dark green and white variegated foliage.
- **Flower:** Prolific scarlet flower clusters with pink centers are a hummingbird paradise.
