- **Use:** This exciting new cultivar boasts voluptuous midnight-soaked blossoms from spring until fall. It remains unmatched in beauty, being the only black petunia today. A vigorous petunia, eager to imbue any container or bed. Quickly forms dense masses of downy green leaves, magnificently cloaked with silken black blooms. Great for use in containers, flowerbeds, and large landscapes. Loved by hummingbirds. Think of black as the "new neutral" -- combine with apricot, white, silver, or chartreuse for a unique and unusual display.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results.
- **Growth:** Stretching 8 to 12 inches tall and almost 12 inches across.
- **Hardiness:** 8-11 Annual, Vigorously branching plants have an upright mounding habit, making it perfect for containers or the flowerbed.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Pinch back tips occasionally for a super bushy plant.
- **Flower:** Its velvety black trumpets with a marked, sweet fragrance offer design opportunities galore from spring until fall.
