Solenostemon scutellarioides 'Dipt in Wine'

- **Use:** These new, bigger, sun loving varieties have revolutionized container gardening. Also tolerates some shade. The brilliant colors explode in sunny locations. Coleus plants are durable and easy to grow. Grows quickly and puts on a massive display during the summer.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun – shade (less color on leaves in shade) Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Superb in borders, beds, and open woodland gardens.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly 12-20" tall or more and 2' wide
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 9-10, annual or houseplant, some people have luck with them coming back in sheltered locations
- **Foliage:** Cutting grown. The glowing yellow boss at the heart of each leaf blends to a deep, mottled maroon near the tip. Leaves have scalloped, sun-lit edges. Coleus 'Dipt in Wine' was a star in our containers last summer.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers, but they are small flowers on purple stalks in fall.
