

# Dancing Queen Amaryllis



**As cheerful as a child's pinwheel, the red-and-white striped blooms of this beauty are sure to prompt a smile every time you look at them.**

## ***Amaryllis hippeastrum* 'Dancing Queen'**

- **Use:** This is truly a premium Amaryllis with a generous double layer of petals. The Amaryllis you see offered at the chain stores bear absolutely no resemblance to the lusty giants we secure through special contracts with Dutch growers. Our bulbs produce 2 flower stems, each with at least 4 blooms, and are easily grown on from year to year. Dutch Amaryllis will bloom about 8–10 weeks from arrival.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant when established, prefers slightly moist soil, but must be well-drained.
- **Growth:** Grows 18" tall and 12" wide.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 7-10; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long, strap-like leaves.
- **Flower:** Resembling peony flowers, they will take your breath away. This stunning beauty mesmerizes the viewer with extra large, luscious, frilly edged, double flowers, up to 9 in. Double Amaryllis seem to bloom sooner than single types.
