Amaryllis hippeastrum 'Desire'

- **Use:** Desire heats things up mid winter with vibrantly colored blooms, usually 4 to 6 to a stem, and often two or even three stems per bulb. Lots of pop right when you need it most. The Amaryllis you see offered at the chain stores bear absolutely no resemblance to the lusty giants we secure through special contracts with a Dutch grower. Our bulbs produce two flower stems, each with at least four blooms, and are easily grown on from year to year. Dutch Amaryllis will bloom about 8–10 weeks from arrival.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant when established, prefers slightly moist soil, but must be well-drained.
- **Growth:** Grows 18" tall and 12" wide.
- **Hardiness:** 7-10 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long, strap-like leaves.
- **Flower:** Salmon colored blossoms. After flowers have faded keep watering bulb lightly until last spring frost and then plant in your garden.
