Double King Amaryllis



Comes back every year and very easy to grow!

Amaryllis 'Double King'

- <u>Use:</u> The shapely blooms and rich, iridescent colors of Amaryllis light up a cold day like nothing else we know.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant when established, but prefers moist soil, but must be well-drained.
- **Growth:** The non-invasive stems spread out to 12-18" tall and 6-8" wide.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 7-10; Perennial; Herbaceous. (it is claimed that they are cold hardy down to zone 6) In zones 7 and below, we recommend deep planting (up to 4 inches of soil above the bulb) and a thick winter mulch.
- Foliage: Deciduous. Long, strap-like leaves.
- Flower: The rich red blossoms of this remarkable double are 8" across, sometimes larger, and carry a hint of fragrance. All produce at least 2 blossoms per dark purple stem, and they appreciate staking to support the hefty blooms. Allow 8–10 weeks from bulb to bloom.
