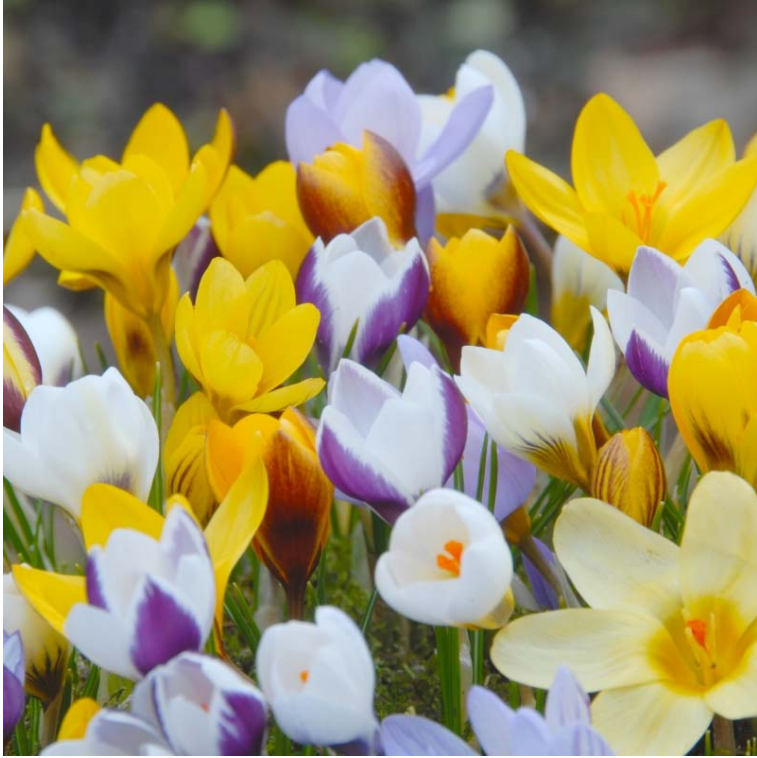


Snow Chrysanthus Mix Crocus



- **Planting density: 3-4 inch apart, 10 per sq. ft.**
- **Planting depth: 3-4 inches to base of the bulb.**
- **Best planted in a mass of 60 or more for dramatic effect.**

Crocus chrysanthus 'Mix'

- **Use:** Specie crocus are a little smaller than the dutch/large flowering crocus and also flower earlier in January/February. These crocus are some of the earliest bulbs to flower and as such they welcome in the spring after those long winter days. The first sign of spring! Use them in borders or edging; in groups of a dozen or hundreds or thousands for naturalizing; in the grass, woodlands, slopes, or under trees. This is one of those diminutive flowers that exemplifies the magic of nature, a tiny miracle that pushes through the snow to surprise and delight. Crocuses naturalize well and gently spread over time. Excellent planted with early blooming crocus
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Grows 4-6" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4 –8 Bulb. Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Small grass-like foliage.
- **Flower:** This is a superb mixtrue of dwarf crocus taken from the chrysanthus and specie crocus that we offer. The mixture will bring early colour to the garden or containers.
