

Ruby Giant Snow Crocus



- Planting density: 2-3 inch apart, 10 per sq. ft.
- Planting depth: 3-4 inches to base of the bulb.
- Best planted in a mass of 60 or more for dramatic effect.

Crocus tommasinianus 'Ruby Giant'

- **Use:** The blooms gleam reddish purple, an exceptionally good solid color. Vigorous and showy, 'Ruby Giant' is somewhat squirrel resistant. For a real splash, plant this crocus alongside bulbs with yellow flowers. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Grows 5-7" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4 –8 Bulb. Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Small grass-like foliage.
- **Flower:** Flower have reddish purple petals with lighter bases. Early.
