

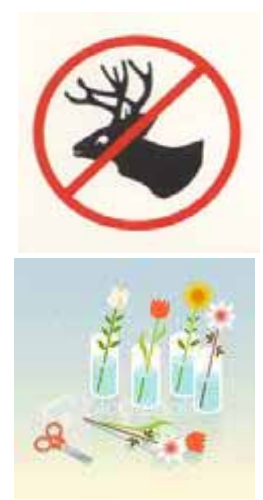
# Dutch Master Daffodils

## *Narcissus 'Dutch Master' (King Alfred Improved)*

- **Use:** Beds, rock gardens, in patio planters, and woodland garden. We find it to truly be the easiest bulb to plant in the garden. Narcissus blooms are for many gardeners the first visible signs of spring. Deer Resistant. Good cut flower. Daffodils are the most cost effective, pest-free perennial plants available and make wonderful companions with other bulbs, perennials, annuals and flowering shrubs.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Grows 13" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8. Perennial. Bulb.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Do not cut off the leaves after flowering.
- **Flower:** Classic 'daffodil'; all medium yellow with long, straight trumpet that flares at the end and has serrated edges



- **Planting density:** 6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- **Planting depth:** 8 inches to base of the bulb.
- **Best planted in a mass of 30 or more for dramatic effect.**
