

Tulip Blue Diamond



- **Planting density:** 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- **Planting depth:** 6-8 inches to base of the bulb.
- **Best planted in a mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.**

Tulipa 'Blue Diamond' (Double late tulip)

- **Use:** Unusual, violet-blue blooms and a profusion of perfectly formed petals characterize this late blooming variety. Plant them en masse for optimum effect or combine them in a colourful mixed border for a dazzling display. High impact blooms to bring colour and joy to your garden. A truly extraordinary flower. With a past steeped in romance it has been a muse for art, poetry and passion. Beds, rock gardens, in patio planters, and woodland gardens.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall.
- **Growth:** Grows 12-14" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8 Perennial; Bulb
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The long green leaves.
- **Flower:** Beautifully formed double, purple-violet flowers (no Tulips are truly blue -- yet). Late Midseason.
