

# Tulip Candy Prince



- **Planting density: 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.**
- **Planting depth: 6-8 inches to base of the bulb.**  
**Best planted in a mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.**

## *Tulipa 'Candy Prince' (Single Early type)*

- **Use:** One of the most popular single early tulips, Candy Prince is a must have in the garden. For endless purple color in the spring garden we suggest to plant in concert with Crocus 'Flower Record', Hyacinth 'Purple Voice', and Allium 'Globemaster'. An ensemble like this will bloom from late February until June.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall.
- **Growth:** Grows 24" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8 Perennial Bulb
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long strap-like leaves.
- **Flower:** Early blooming, in soft purple this tulip is perfect match for red and white early or late tulips too. Blooming early spring.
