

Orange Rosalie Tulip



- **Planting density:** 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- **Planting depth:** 6-8 inches to base of the bulb.
- **Best planted in a mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.**

Tulipa 'Orange Rosalie' (Triumph type)

- **Use:** Reliable and beautiful early to mid season flowers. Great colour and great performance, these Tulips are real all rounders. In beds or pots they are reliable and beautiful. Tulip-mania might have transpired nearly four hundred years ago but the spirit lives on in gardeners everywhere! For a show-stopping attraction in your garden, plant tulips in a group of 30 to 60.

Exposure/Soil: Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall.

- **Growth:** Grows 18-20" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8 Perennial Bulb
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long strap-like leaves.
- **Flower:** Violet pink with orange stripes.
