

# Tulip Pinnochio



## *Tulipa 'Pinnochio' (Greiggi type)*

- **Use:** This cheerful striped favorite is deep scarlet-red, edged in contrasting ivory-white with an interior lemon-yellow base. Beds, rock gardens, in patio planters, and woodland gardens. With its good looks and carefree nature, it's a longtime favorite in gardens across the country. For a show-stopping attraction in your garden, plant tulips in a group of 25 to 50.
  - **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall.
  - **Growth:** Grows 10" tall.
  - **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8 Perennial Bulb
  - **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long strap leaves have stripes.
  - **Flower:** Deep scarlet red flowers are edged ivory white, for a beautiful effect which highlights both colours.
- Planting density: 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
  - Planting depth: 6-8 inches to base of the bulb.
  - Best planted in a mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.
