

# Tulip Robinho



- Planting density: 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- Planting depth: 6-8 inches to base of the bulb.
- Best planted in a mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.

## *Tulipa 'Robinho'*

- **Use:** These fragrant beauties of a rosy cream color are as romantic as tulips can get! The blooms of this Finola Double Tulip appear in last spring on sturdy stems that stand up to blustery spring winds. Represents perfect love & eternal happiness! Beds, rock gardens, in patio planters, and woodland gardens. With its good looks and care-free nature, it's a longtime favorite in gardens across the country. For a show-stopping attraction in your garden, plant tulips in a group of 25 to 50.

**Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall.

- **Growth:** Grows 16-18" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8 Perennial Bulb
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long strap leaves have stripes.
- **Flower:** This Double Late Tulip is a subtle blend of pink and white, with occasional green feathering on the outer petals. Good for cutting. Late.
