

Tropical Lady Tulip



- Planting density: 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- Planting depth: 6-8 inches to base of the bulb.
- Best planted in a mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.

Tulipa 'Tropical Lady' (Triumph type)

- **Use:** Tulip Tropical Lady is a mid-spring blooming Triumph tulip bulb that looks like flowers from the tropics with its variegation in the leaves matching the flower. A strong, long lasting, disease resistant and has richly colored flowers and leaves. Tulips are incredibly diverse, and will enrich any flower garden situation. Beds, rock gardens, in patio planters, and woodland gardens. For a show-stopping attraction in your garden, plant tulips in a group of 30 to 60.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall.
- **Growth:** Grows 13-18" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8 Perennial Bulb
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long strap-like leaves with white edging. The clean looking foliage adds another dimension of interest to this mid-spring blooming favorite!
- **Flower:** Adored for its soft pink blooms but the real stand out feature of this tulip is the white and green variegated foliage.
