

# Vanilla Cream Tulip



- **Planting density: 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.**
- **Planting depth: 6-8 inches to base of the bulb.**
- **Best planted in a mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.**

## ***Tulipa 'Tropical Lady' (Greigii type)***

- **Use:** As the creamy white petals open and show their yellow lining, the blossoms of 'Vanilla Cream' take on a sunny glow. Purplish brown veins on the broad, wavy leaves, a sign of Greigii Tulip parentage, are decorative before and after the flowers take center stage. Midseason. For a show-stopping attraction in your garden, plant tulips in a group of 30 to 60.

**Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall.

- **Growth:** Grows 16-20" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8 Perennial Bulb
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long strap-like leaves with white edging. The clean looking foliage adds another dimension of interest to this mid-spring blooming favorite!
- **Flower:** Another of the taller, new Greigii hybrids, this charmer is soft cream-yellow with a dark stem and moderately mottled foliage.
