

Lilac Wonder Wildflower Tulip



- **Planting density:** 2-3 inch apart, 9 per sq. ft.
- **Planting depth:** 2-4 inches to base of the bulb.
- **Best planted in a mass of 45 or more for dramatic effect.**

Tulipa bakeri 'Lilac Wonder'

- **Use:** Lilac Wonder Tulip is an unusual and distinctive wildflower tulip with gorgeous mauve-pink petals surrounding a soft yellow center. A long lived, vigorous grower. They are more perennial than other types of tulips in our hot Georgia gardens. With good drainage and lots of sun, they are especially long-lived.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall.
- **Growth:** Grows 4-6" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8 Perennial, Bulb
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long strap-like, green leaves.
- **Flower:** An unusual and distinctive tulip with gorgeous mauve-pink petals surrounding a soft yellow center. This tulip naturalizes easily, meaning it will multiply and spread, returning each year.
