## ***Beta 'Bright Lights'***

- **Use:** Plant them behind your pansies or in containers on your patio! Plants produce eye-appealing stalk colors of deep gold, snow white, deep red and magenta, all with shiny, medium-green colored leaves. The stalks are broad, very tender and fleshy even at full maturity. The leaves and stalks make a delicious and nutritious green when lightly steamed.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Grows 21-26" tall.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9; annual, winter hardy
- **Foliage:** Stalks of yellow, orange, pink, crimson, purple, white, or green -- many with stripes as well! Some even keep their color after cooking!
- **Flowers:** Not known for flowers.
