
Red Russian Kale

Brassica oleracea 'Red Russian'

- <u>Use:</u> With finely curled deep red leaves this variety is very popular in winter gardening. As vegetable this Kale is very tasty with leaves getting sweeter in late fall after the first frost. The deep color is not only attractive in you ornamental bed with snapdragons and pansies but it can be used in salads as additional color.
- Exposure/Soil: Plant in full sun. Prefers moist, rich soils with good drainage.
- Growth: Grows 18-24" tall and 12-14" wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 4-8; Annual; Lasts all winter and spring.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Evergreen in our mild winters. Adds a colorful pizzazz to salads and offers something new and different for the market. Vigorous and cold resistant.
- *Flower:* Tall stalks of sulfur yellow flowers in spring.
