

Allstar Strawberry



The largest, firm, glossy berries are produced on this disease resistant variety.

Fragaria 'Allstar'

- **Use:** Allstar bears in late midseason and produces berries actually as large as plums! Frost resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun, but will take a little shade. Try to keep water off the leaves when watering. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Fertilize with a bloom food.
- **Growth:** Continues to trail all season long!
- **Hardiness:** 5-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; May keep some leaves in the winter if it is mild.
- **Flower:** Fragrant blossoms produce sweet red berries! As a May-June-bearer, Allstar yields large, firm strawberries for a few weeks in late spring to early summer, making it a good choice for preserves or freezing.
