Lactuca sativa 'Buttercrunch'

- <u>Use:</u> This bibb-type head lettuce has a large compact yellow-white heart. It grows dark-green, red-tinged, thick, tender, richly flavored leaves in loose 4_" rosettes. This heat-resistant variety is long lasting, bolt resistant, and free of mosaic disease. It was an All-American Selections winner in 1963.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun and keep the soil evenly moist.
- **Growth:** Grows 6-12" tall and wide and larger. 30 days to baby lettuce; 55 or less days to full size.
- <u>Hardiness/Harvest Time</u>: Harvest the entire plant when mature, but still young and crisp. All lettuces are at their best when picked as needed and used immediately. Head lettuce will only last a few days in the refrigerator before deteriorating.
- <u>Leaf:</u> This extremely popular lettuce has a luscious, buttery texture. The soft heads are creamy yellow inside and have some heat resistance.
