- Lycopersicum Big Boy Hybrid Indeterminate type
- <u>Use</u>: Big Boy, with sweet, fragrant, red, smooth-skinned fruit that can weigh a pound or more, is one of the most popular tomatoes. Experts often list it amongst their top five all-time favorites. The plant form is indeterminate, but it is bush-like in habit, a strong grower and blessed with good disease resistance. Crack resistant.
- Exposure/Soil: Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- Growth: Grows 36" tall and 36" wide. Set plants 2 to 2 1/2 feet apart.
- Hardiness: 9-11, annual, houseplant.
- Foliage: Small, lacy leaves.
- **Flower:** Plant produces good yields of very flavorful 1 lb meaty tomatoes. Tomatoes turn bright red when mature.
