Lycopersicum 'Pink Girl' (Indeterminate)

- **Use:** Pink Girl is a vigorous vine that produces throughout the summer. Heavy producer of pink fruits, averaging 6 to 8 oz. Fruits are extremely crack-resistant and low in acid. Rich flavor and superior quality in a disease resistant variety. A season-long high yielder.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Grows 5-6' tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11, annual, houseplant.
- **Foliage:** Lacy leaves
- **Fruit:** Pink Girl is a large, juicy hybrid tomato that weighs up to one-half pound. The fruit is pearly pink with mild flavor and good resistance to cracking. Vigorous plants bear throughout the summer, and need to be staked or caged. Resistant to verticillium (V), fusarium (F), alternaria stem canker (A), and gray leaf spot (St).
