

# Husky Red Tomato



**Requiring no pruning, the dwarf, indeterminate vines will grow to about 4ft. Plants are resistant to Verticillium Wilt, Fusarium Wilt (Races 1 and 2), Alternaria Stem Canker, and Gray Leaf Spot (Stemphylium).**

- ***Lycopersicum 'Husky Red'***
- **Use:** You'll be amazed at the large, 5-7 ounce fruits harvested from this beautiful dwarf tomato plant! Husky Red is a highly productive indeterminate variety that grows like a determinate. Resistant to a variety of diseases, including verticillium wilt, fusarium wilt (races 1 and 2), alternaria stem canker and gray leaf spot, this is an ideal choice for containers, raised beds or small garden spaces. 68 days to maturity.
- **Exposure/Soil:** FULL SUN! Soak to depth of 6 to 10 inches when watering. They need at least 6 hours of direct sunlight a day. Tomatoes hate red clay so use a good soil such as our PRO\_MIX.
- **Growth:** Grows 4– 8' tall and wide. Needs a very strong wooden stake or a tomato cage is best.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11, Annual, houseplant.
- **Foliage:** Dark green quilted leaves.
- **Fruit:** Look for a no-nonsense yield of 7oz, medium-size red Tomatoes for sandwiches, salads, and fresh eating about 67-70 days from transplant.
