

Golden Culinary Oregano



Plants are great for edging, or in tubs and mixed containers.

Origanum vulgare 'Aureum'

- **Use:** Golden-hued leaves will be generously interspersed with yellowish-green leaves, while in cooler climates the mounds will be almost completely gold. Its compact growing habit makes it desirable for smaller garden plots while its pink and purple decorative blossoms atop the unique foliage will add interest along walkways and borders. Attractive to butterflies.
- **Exposure/Soil:** They love full hot sun, but be sure to keep them well watered, but not drowning. Pinch tips back occasionally to produce a bushy plant! Use slow release fertilizer for best results
- **Growth:** Grows 12"-36" tall and continues to 6-12" spread wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4--10; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Golden oregano is a robust creeper with tiny, rounded leaves 1/2 to 1 inch wide.
- **Flower:** Small, pink or lavender to purple flowers stand out above the foliage in early to late summer.
