Punica granatum 'Nana'

- **Use:** Showy, dense dwarf shrub displays attractive orange-red single flowers at an early age, followed by colorful fruit. Excellent for containers or for use in the garden.
- **Exposure:** Full to partial sun. Follow a regular watering schedule during the first growing season to establish a deep, extensive root system. Feed with a general purpose fertilizer before new growth begins in spring. For a tidy, neat appearance, shear annually to shape. Pruning time: early spring.
- **Growth:** Moderate, 3' tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** 7-11; shrub (can also be a bonsai indoors).
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Small elongated leaves.
- **Flower:** Showy red blossoms attract hummingbirds and then turn into tasty fruits in late summer/ early fall.
