

1 gal Barbeque Rosemary



Rosemarinus officinalis 'Barbeque'

- **Use:** Foliage of this selection has especially good flavor and aroma for cooking. Strong, straight stems make perfect barbecue skewers! In the landscape Rosemary is used in hot, sunny locations as it is very drought resistant and withstands the heat and humidity well.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Must have good drainage as it can't stand soggy feet. Water regularly when top 3in of soil is dry, best to allow soil to dry between waterings though..
- **Growth:** Moderate growing 4 to 6 ft. tall, 2 to 3 ft. wide. Takes to pruning well, perfect for hedging or screens.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-9; shrub /herb
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Fragrant, thin bluish-green leaves.
- **Flowers:** The small blue flowers that appear in mid summer are edible as well, and make a nice garnish for salads.

As an herb, Rosemary is used to flavor meat dishes, and condiments., but can also be a lovely & fragrant hedge
