

Rosemary



As an herb, Rosemary is used to flavor meat dishes, and condiments.

Rosemarinus officinalis 'Tuscan Blue'

- **Use:** In the landscape Rosemary is used in hot, sunny locations as it is very drought resistant and withstands the heat and humidity well.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Must have good drainage as it can't stand soggy feet.
- Water regularly when top 3in of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate-growing shrub to 6 feet tall, 2 to 4 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** 7-9; shrub /herb
- **Foliage:** Evergreen.
- **Flowers:** The small blue flowers that appear in mid summer are edible as well, and make a nice garnish for salads.
