

Trailing Rosemary



As an herb, Rosemary is used to flavor meat dishes, and condiments.

Rosmarinus officinalis 'Prostratus'

- **Use:** A beautiful carpet of deep blue flowers backed by fragrant foliage forms a small, attractive spreading groundcover. Useful in erosion control. Foliage can be used as a flavorful spice in cooking. Good shrub for cascading in planters and over retaining walls.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Must have good drainage as it can't stand soggy feet.
- Water regularly when top 3in of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Low growing shrub to 1 foot tall, 6-8 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** 7-9; shrub /herb
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Dark green leaves, to 2 inches long, are rich in aromatic oils and commonly used as a culinary herb.
- **Flowers:** The small blue flowers that appear in mid summer are edible as well, and make a nice garnish for salads.
